

AWARD DESCRIPTIONS

President's Award for Outstanding Commitment

Recognizes employees who go above and beyond their normal responsibilities in delivering on commitments to clients, partners, and the VETS team.

President's Award for Excellence in Innovation

Recognizes employees or teams that foster the entrepreneurial spirit by delivering a new, innovative, creative, clever, or unique idea/ way of doing business.

President's Award for Inspirational Leadership

Recognizes an employee who has inspired others in the workplace, or outside the workplace, in a way that is truly amazing.

VETS President's Partnership Award

This award is presented to a partner employee that has gone out of her or his way to support a joint project. It reflects partnership, teamwork, dedication and outstanding support as part of a team effort.

VETS Award for Exceptional Impact

Recognizes an individual or team that has had a significant impact on VETS business by building trust and respect with a client, a partner, or within a team.

VETS 360 Degree Honor
